Because of the great importance of this current message, presented in the recent *Tidings of Zion*, we are sending out an extra flash card this month to call your attention to the Solemn Assembly taking place in September 2020. This is a call to revival in the church. Richard Neill: Following the Elders Conference in the summer of 2019, the Lord spoke these words to me: **“My people have become my Living Church.** In my 47 years of ministry, I have been made aware of the “windows of heaven” being opened and the “windows of heaven” being shut. A few years ago, the “window” was opened in the Restoration. As the Lord made this known, I also became aware that because of our weakness and failure to respond obediently, the “window” became closed for a time. In my sadness, I made a commitment to the Lord. I said to him, “Lord, if you ever tell me again that the windows of heaven are open, I commit to you I will be all-in.” After pondering the message, the Lord spoke further and said, **“The window is open.”**

In Malachi 3:10 there is the classic reference to the “windows of heaven” becoming open...talking about tithes, but it has a broader application of what happens to a people when they are obedient. What are the promises that the Lord makes of the window being opened if we are obedient? (*For the list refer to mailing side of card.) **In order to claim a blessing, the people must be humble and full of love, diligent, and obedient to God. When the people see and know the window is open, they must be ready and prepared to carry out the Lord's commands.**

Are You ready to claim the blessing? Let us move out quickly to prepare ourselves for this great event, this upcoming Solemn Assembly.
