


October Week #3 Devotionals & Consideration



Hymn: “Let Us Pray for One Another”

Alma gives us wonderful direction on prayer, “**Yea, humble yourselves, and continue in prayer unto him; cry unto him when ye are in your fields; yea, over all your flocks; cry unto him in your houses, yea, over all your household, both**

morning, mid-day, and evening; ...cry unto the Lord, let your hearts be full, drawn out in prayer unto him continually for your welfare, and also for the welfare of those who are around you” Alma 16:219.

Are you developing good prayer habits so that you are praying daily for those around you?

Ask yourself how you can improve your prayer life and set a goal for the coming month.

D&C 28:1a Listen to the voice of Jesus Christ, your Redeemer, the great I AM, Whose arm of mercy hath atoned for your sins, who will gather His people even as a hen gathereth her chickens under her wings; even as many as will hearken to My voice, and humble themselves before Me, and call upon Me in mighty prayer.

2 Nephi 15:4 For I pray continually for them by day, and mine eyes water my pillow by night, because of them; and I cry unto my God in faith, and I know that He will hear my cry; and I know that the Lord God will consecrate my prayers, for the gain of my people.
